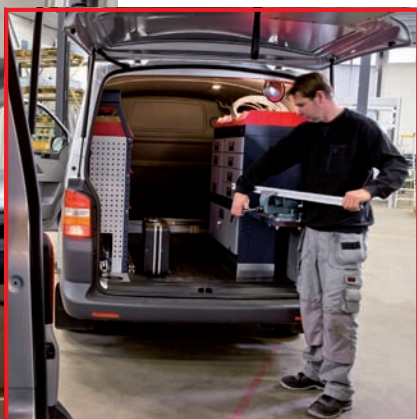
Sign a support and service contract.

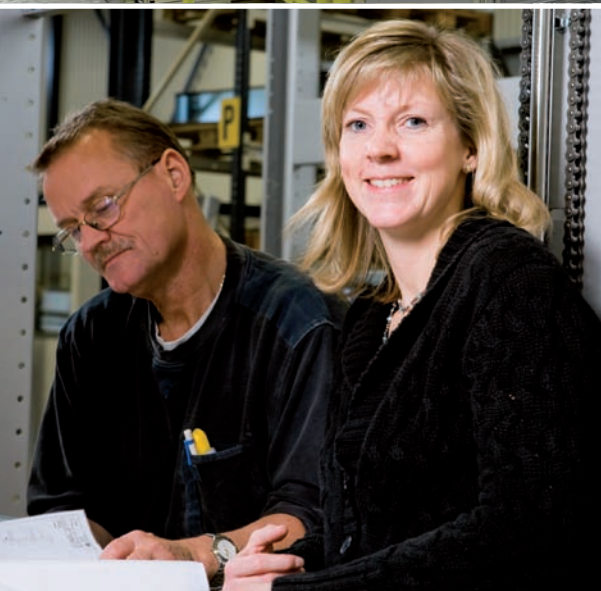
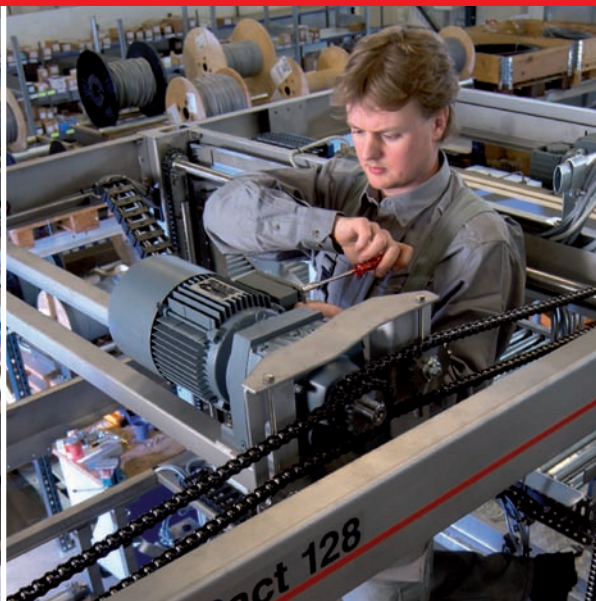
